

### **EAC seeking Volunteers for One Day Soil Sampling Project at Brightside Farm**

Residents are invited to join us to sample the soils at Brightside Farm as preparation for the possible installation of a riparian buffer on a headwater of Pigeon Run by the Environmental Advisory Council.

The goal of the planting is to improve the water quality of Pigeon Run, and more will be presented about this in the future once it is approved by the Township.

The soil sampling is an opportunity to learn this simple process that anyone can use to help choose the plants/shrubs/trees that will adapt best to a site. I will be sampling the soil at Brightside Farm on Saturday May 18 at 12 noon. Interested persons should arrive 15 minutes ahead for an overview and so that they can find the locations where I will be sampling. Heavy rain will cancel and a new notice will be sent.
