

CHARLESTOWN TOWNSHIP OFFICE CLOSED FOR TWO WEEKS DUE TO COVID-19

ESSENTIAL SERVICES ONLY

After communication with the County on best practices and after careful consideration, Charlestown Township will be following the county's lead and activating an "essential services only" operation for the next two weeks due to the coronavirus (COVID-19).

This will be effective at 9:00 AM today, March 16th until 9:00 AM Monday, March 30th.

As more and more institutions close, this is the best decision we can make for the health, safety, and welfare of our employees and the general public.

The following is a summary of what is to take place:

- There will be 1 - 2 employees in the office each day during the two weeks to answer phones.
- The PA State Police and your other Emergency Services will be operating normally.
- Township Roads/Public Works will be working on an on-call basis for emergencies such as downed trees, storm response, etc.
- Parks and their restroom facilities will be closed. Use of the trails is permitted.

There will be no public admitted to the Township Building for any reason.
