

MAY 12TH PUBLIC MEETING:

THE DEVAULT TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY

Local residents from Charlestown Township, Schuylkill Township, the Borough of Phoenixville and surrounding communities will have an opportunity on Monday, May 12th to learn more about the Devault Trail Feasibility Study, a trail project to identify a multi-use pathway between Devault and Phoenixville. The Trail would ideally connect with the Schuylkill River Trail in Phoenixville, and with the proposed Warner Loop in Devault. The study includes examining the possible use of the rail line running from Devault to Phoenixville.

Area bicyclists, walkers, horse riders, nature lovers, and outdoor enthusiasts will be able to participate in an evening workshop and express their ideas for the project.

Charlestown Township has joined with Chester County to conduct a study to determine the feasibility of a trail connecting Devault and Phoenixville. With funding provided by the County's Vision Partnership Program, and Charlestown Township, the County and the Township have contracted with Campbell Thomas & Company of Philadelphia, PA to conduct the study. Ray Ott & Associates of West Chester is serving as part of the Campbell Thomas & Co. team.



A public workshop will be held on **May 12, 2014 between 7:30 and 9:00 p.m. in the cafeteria of the Great Valley Middle School, 255 Phoenixville Pike, Malvern, PA 19355.**

Participants can stop in at any time during the workshop to share their ideas. Maps and a questionnaire will be provided to facilitate each person's input. Representatives of the County, the Township, the Study Committee, and the Consulting Team will be available to receive your input and questions.
