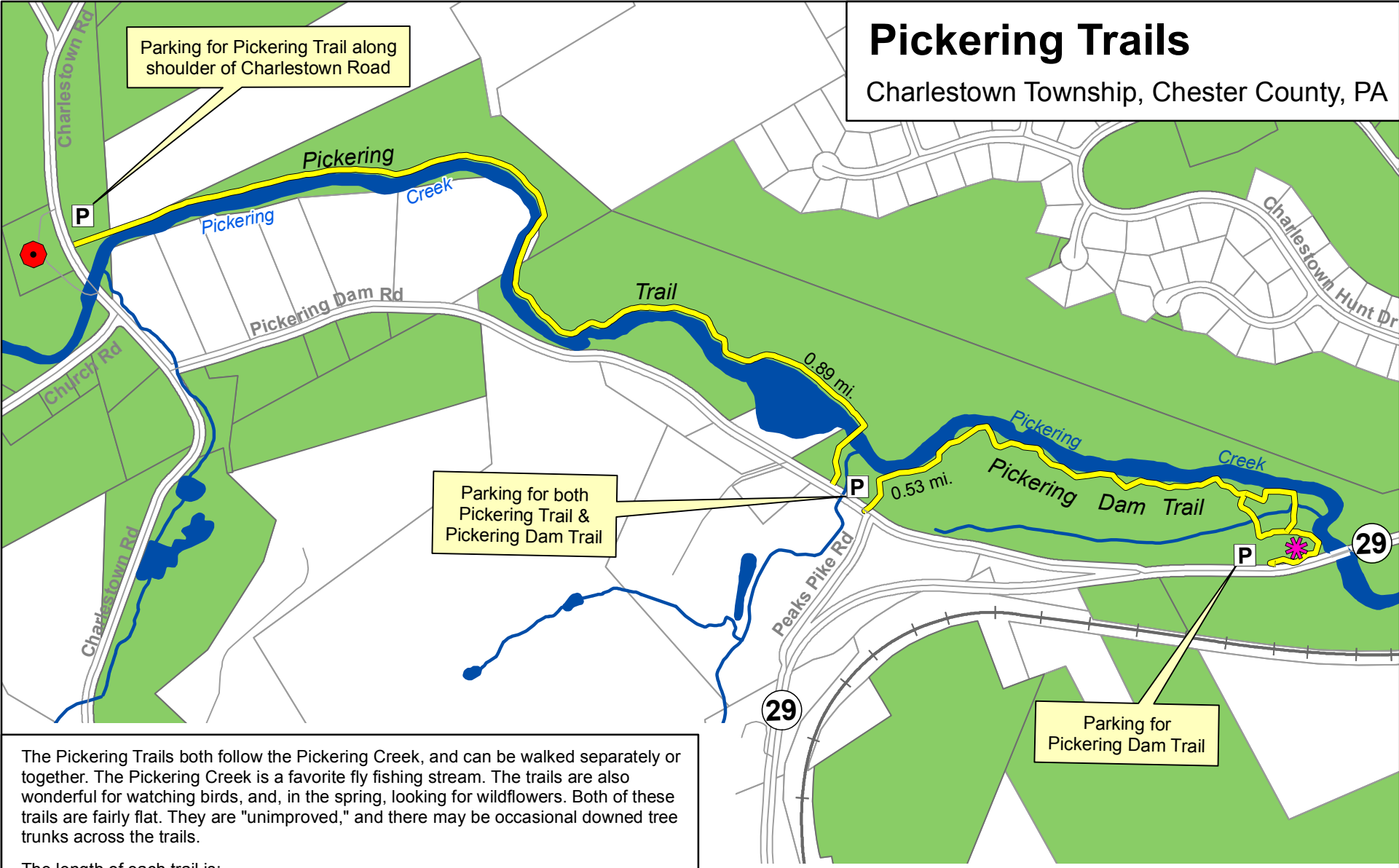


Pickering Trails

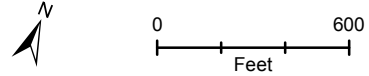
Charlestown Township, Chester County, PA



The Pickering Trails both follow the Pickering Creek, and can be walked separately or together. The Pickering Creek is a favorite fly fishing stream. The trails are also wonderful for watching birds, and, in the spring, looking for wildflowers. Both of these trails are fairly flat. They are "unimproved," and there may be occasional downed tree trunks across the trails.

The length of each trail is:
 Pickering Trail: 0.89 miles
 Pickering Dam Trail: 0.53 miles

- Limited parking for both trails is available on Pickering Dam Road.
- Limited parking and access to the Pickering Dam Trail is available on Route 29, just south of the Ice Dam. Follow the trail signs and white blazes to access the trail.
- Parking and access to the Pickering Trail is available on Charlestown Road opposite the Mill. Follow the trail signs.
