Re: Temporary Closing of Coldstream Road April 6th

Dear Residents,

Charlestown Township is having its roadside Earth Day litter clean up on April 6<sup>th</sup> with a rain date of April 13<sup>th</sup>.

This year, one of your neighbors volunteered to assemble a group of volunteers to perform a clean-up along Coldstream Road. As you know, due to the sharp curve and volume/speed of traffic, this is too dangerous to do while the road is open and the reason why we haven't done it in the past.

The Township obtained approval from PennDOT to close Coldstream Road between Township Line Road and Charlestown Road for two hours on Saturday, April 6<sup>th</sup> (or rain date April 13<sup>th</sup>) from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. While the road will be barricaded against through traffic, local traffic will still be permitted during these hours.

We would, however, be greatly appreciative of your cooperation in the following ways:

1. Delay your trip until after 9:00 a.m. if possible
2. Take an alternative route if one is available
3. Allow for extra time if you need to travel on Coldstream Road
